Reception Trips, Workshops and Enhancement Activities –2026

Reception- Star and Comet - have several exciting trips coming up over the next two terms, including visits to Hounslow Urban Farm and St Michael's Church. We have also arranged a variety of additional activities and external workshops to come into school to enhance the children's learning:

Spring Term



On **Monday 23rd February**, we will be receiving some 'Living Eggs' as part of our topic 'Animals and Growth.' We will be able to watch the eggs hatch and then care for the babies over the next fortnight. We are keeping the type of eggs a secret for now!

Friday 6th March, the whole school will join together to mark this year's World Books Day. Children are invited to come dressed as their favourite book character for the day. We will be doing shared reading with some of the older children and doing lots of fun activities in class all based around our love of books



Monday 9th March begins a fun and exciting 'Science Week' throughout the school. We have arranged a workshop for the children to inspire their scientific curiosity in readiness for our carousel of activities at the end of the week!



Wednesday 25th March is our Spring Assembly. Children will be performing a range of songs and poems inspired by the season. Please keep the date free!



Thursday 26th March, we will be visiting All Saints Church to learn about the Easter Story and why this is celebrated by Christians. **We will need parents to help walk with us to and from the Church** (12.45pm-3.15pm)



Summer Term

Wednesday 22nd April, children will be visiting Hounslow Urban Farm to take part in a variety of animal handling session and to meet all of the baby animals. **We will need parent's help on the trip as we are travelling by bus and will stay at the farm for the whole day.**



Tuesday 16th June (Star) / Thursday 18th June (Comet), children will be visiting Hanworth Library for a special story time session led by library staff. **We will need parents to help walk with us to and from the library on both days.**



For all of our trips the children will need to be wearing full school uniform, sensible shoes, a waterproof coat and bring a water bottle.

Please let your child's class teacher know if you are available to accompany us on any of the trips. **We are required by law to have one adult for every 4 children so these can not go ahead without you!**
