


How to do your work on Google Classrooms


Hopefully you know your email address and password, which should be in your yellow reading diary. If not, contact the school office and this can be found for you.

Once you log-in you SHOULD go straight to Google Classrooms.

If for some reason you have logged into Google but NOT the Google Classroom, you will see this screen:




You can click on the 9 dots in the right-hand corner to find your Google Classroom:




Your Google Classroom homepage will look like this (but Ariane Class will say Ariane, not Mariner!).


Click on the name of your class to find your class 'stream'.




Your stream looks like a social media stream- the most recent posts are first, and you can leave comments on here too. Your daily timetable will always be on here. Click on it to see it.




Click on the document. You do not need to have Microsoft Word to view it.



This is the same for your Story Time video. Click on it to view it.




To do your work on Google Classrooms, you can EITHER click on the link on your stream...



... or click the 'To do' link on your home page. They will both take you to the work.

To do Calendar



When you click on the work, you will see a Google document to edit (see below). Good news- you don't need to share or save it anywhere- it automatically saves itself every few seconds! However, when you are finished you MUST click 'Hand in', otherwise no-one can see it or mark it for you.
