Year 5 Trips Autumn 2024

Year 5 have several trips this term, including visits to The London Eye and the Science Museum.

On **Friday 27th September**, Year 5 will be heading to the London Eye to further our conceptual understanding of our current English book, *The London Eye Mystery* by Siobhan Dowd.

As part of our Science topic Forces, we will be heading to the Science Museum on **Wednesday 11th December**. The children will spend time in a forces workshop, experience Wonderlab and have some teacher-led exploration time.

We will be using public transport for both of these trips, **leaving school promptly at 09:00** and aiming to return **by 15:15**. Children will need a packed lunch in a rucksack and a bottle of water. Please inform the school if you require a lunch to be provided.

Children must wear full school uniform and comfortable shoes/trainers, and bring an appropriate coat.

Please let your child's class teacher know if you are available to accompany us on any of the trips. We already have enough volunteers for the London Eye trip, thank you for being so proactive. We have a specific ratio with which to comply when we are on trips, therefore we need advance notice of which adults are attending, and once you have agreed to attend, it is important that you fulfil this commitment.

In addition to these trips, all of KS2 will be attending a trip to the cinema. On **Thursday 28th November**, we will be walking to Cineworld in Feltham to take part in the 'Into Film Festival'. We will return to school in time for lunch on this day.

I'm sure the children have told you about the local art trip we have already had, to Feltham Circles.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £15 to cover the cost of all these outings for the whole of this term. We would ask that this money is paid through your online account at your earliest convenience.
